*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

SECTION 2. 20.292 (1) (aj) of the statutes is created to read:

1 ~~20.292 (1) (aj) Wisconsin Advantage Jobs Training Programs. The amounts in~~  
2 ~~the schedule for grants to technical college districts under s. 39.39.~~

3 ~~SECTION 3. 38.28 (1m) (a) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act~~  
4 ~~33, is amended to read:~~

5 ~~38.28 (1m) (a) 1. "District aidable cost" means the annual cost of operating a~~  
6 ~~technical college district, including debt service charges for district bonds and~~  
7 ~~promissory notes for building programs or capital equipment, but excluding all~~  
8 ~~expenditures relating to auxiliary enterprises and community service programs, all~~  
9 ~~expenditures funded by or reimbursed with federal revenues, all receipts under sub.~~  
10 ~~(6) and ss. 38.12 (9), 38.14 (3) and (9), 38.39, 118.15 (2) (a), 118.55 (7r), and 146.55~~  
11 ~~(5), all receipts from grants awarded under ss. 38.04 (8), (20), (28), and (31), 38.14~~  
12 ~~(11), 38.26, 38.27, 38.33, and 38.38, all fees collected under s. 38.24, and driver~~

14 ~~SECTION 4.~~ <sup>#</sup> 38.39 of the statutes is created to read:

15 **38.39 Wisconsin Advantage Jobs Training Program.**  With the  
16 approval of the board, a district board may on its own or jointly with any other entity  
17 contract with a business located in the district to provide the business with one or  
18 more of the following:

- 19 (1) ~~(a)~~ Training for jobs created or retained by the business.  
20 (2) ~~(b)~~ Adult basic education.  
21 (3) ~~(c)~~ Vocational and skill-assessment services.  
22 (4) ~~(d)~~ Training facilities, equipment, and material.  
23 (5) ~~(e)~~ Professional services.

24 ~~(2) From the appropriation under s. 20.292 (1) (aj), the board shall award~~  
25 ~~grants to technical college districts to support the costs of contracts under sub. (1).~~

1 The board may not award a grant unless the contract requires the business to match  
2 the amount of the grant.

3 **SECTION 5. Appropriation changes.**

4 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation  
5 to the department of commerce under section 20.143 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected  
6 by the acts of 2003, the dollar amount is decreased by \$1,000,000 for fiscal year  
7 2004-05 to decrease funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
