Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, charter schools established by the city of Milwaukee, the Milwaukee Area Technical College, the University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee, and the University of Wisconsin–Parkside (independent charter schools) receive state funds. The cost of the charter school payments is fully offset by a proportionate reduction in the general school aids of all school districts.

This bill eliminates these reductions in aid to all school districts. Under the bill, payments to the independent charter schools are subtracted only from the general school aid of the school districts in which the charter schools are located.

Currently, the state annually pays the school district in which the University of Wisconsin–Parkside has established a charter school (the Racine Unified School District) an amount equal to the amount of school aid per pupil to which the school district is entitled multiplied by the number of pupils attending the charter school who were previously enrolled in the school district. This bill eliminates these payments.
