



~~Under the current Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (MPCP), the state pays for the cost of children from low-income families in the city of Milwaukee to attend private schools in Milwaukee. Charter schools established by the city of Milwaukee, the Milwaukee Area Technical College, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and the University of Wisconsin-Parkside, receive state funds, as well. The cost of the MPCP payments is partially offset by a reduction in the general school aids otherwise paid to the Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) by an amount equal to 45 percent of the total cost of MPCP. The cost of the charter school payments is fully offset by a proportionate reduction in the general school aids of all school districts.~~



If the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin–Parkside establishes or contracts for the establishment of a charter school under this subsection, in March the department shall pay to the unified school district in which the charter school is located, from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (fm), an amount equal to the amount of school aid per pupil to which the unified school district is eligible in the current school year multiplied by the number of pupils attending the charter school who were previously enrolled in the unified school district.
