## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Summary of Legislation:

This bill prohibits the releasing, possessing, controlling, storing selling or transporting of certain live invasive nonnative aquatic species, including alewife, Asian carp, snakeheads and sea lampreys.

Fiscal Effect:

The bill would have a small ongoing fiscal impact on the Department. The bill would create a prohibition to Wis. Stat. 29: the statute dealing with wild animals and plants. Law Enforcement staff would need to respond to complaints and take enforcement action when faced with violations of the law. In addition, there would be some ongoing costs to continue to inform the public and fish farms about the new law. These costs cannot be estimated, and could be absorbed in the current Law Enforcement budget.

The bill would have a one-time fiscal impact and those costs could be absorbed in existing budgets. The costs would be related to the development of an administrative rule listing any other species that should be covered by the prohibition, and to educating anglers about the bill's provisions if they become law. For instance, anglers now can legally possess live white perch in live wells, and the law would prohibit this. The education efforts would attempt to keep anglers from unknowingly violating the law.
