This bill provides an additional \$378,300 GPR and 5.0 FTE positions for the University of Wisconsin System in the 2004–05 fiscal year in order for the University of Wisconsin–Platteville to provide engineering instruction at the University of Wisconsin–Rock County campus.

SECTION 1. Appropriation changes; University of Wisconsin System.
