ASSEMBLY BILL 811/SENATE BILL 451

Substitute Amendment With \$500,000 GPR

Motion:

Move to introduce and adopt a substitute amendment to Assembly Bill 811/SB 451 to create an annual, GPR appropriation under the WTCS Board with \$500,000 GPR starting in 2004-05 in order to implement the workforce training provisions of AB 796/SB 384. Specify that the Board could not award a grant unless the business would match the grant.

Provide that for purposes of the 2005-07 budget, base funding for this program be treated as if it were \$1,000,000 GPR in 2004-05.

Reduce the Department of Commerce's Wisconsin development fund appropriation by \$500,000 GPR in 2003-04.

Provide that AB 811/SB 451 would be void unless AB 796/SB 384 is enacted into law on or before the effective date of the AB 811/SB 451.

Permit the district board to raise funds or provide support for the Wisconsin advantage program by any means necessary or convenient except as expressly limited by law or board or district board rule.

1 ^{Regen} AN ACT *to renumber* 38.39 (intro.); *to amend* 38.28 (1m) (a) 1.; and *to create*
2 20.292 (1) (aj) and 38.39 (2) of the statutes; **relating to:** grants to technical
3 college districts for the purpose of providing services and facilities to businesses
4 and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert
6 the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

1 **SECTION 2.** 20.292 (1) (aj) of the statutes is created to read:

2 20.292 (1) (aj) *Wisconsin Advantage Jobs Training Programs*. The amounts in
3 the schedule for grants to technical college districts under s. 39.39.

4 **SECTION 3.** 38.28 (1m) (a) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act
5 33, is amended to read:

6 38.28 (1m) (a) 1. "District aidable cost" means the annual cost of operating a
7 technical college district, including debt service charges for district bonds and
8 promissory notes for building programs or capital equipment, but excluding all
9 expenditures relating to auxiliary enterprises and community service programs, all
10 expenditures funded by or reimbursed with federal revenues, all receipts under sub.
11 (6) and ss. 38.12 (9), 38.14 (3) and (9), 38.39, 118.15 (2) (a), 118.55 (7r), and 146.55
12 (5), all receipts from grants awarded under ss. 38.04 (8), (20), (28), and (31), 38.14
13 (11), 38.26, 38.27, 38.33, and 38.38, all fees collected under s. 38.24, and driver
14 education and chauffeur training aids.

15 **SECTION 4.** 38.39 (intro.) of the statutes, as created by 2003 Wisconsin Act ...
16 (SB-384), is renumbered 38.39 (1) (intro.).

17 **SECTION 5.** 38.39 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

18 38.39 (2) From the appropriation under s. 20.292 (1) (aj), the board shall award
19 grants to technical college districts to support the costs of contracts under sub. (1).
20 The board may not award a grant unless the contract requires the business to match
21 the amount of the grant.

22 **SECTION 6. Nonstatutory provisions.**

23 (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, in submitting
24 information under section 16.42 of the statutes for purposes of the 2005-07 biennial
25 budget bill, the technical college system board shall submit information concerning

1 the appropriation under section 20.292 (1) (aj) of the statutes as though \$1,000,000
2 had been appropriated in the 2004-05 fiscal year.

3 (2) This act is void unless 2003 Wisconsin Act ... Senate Bill 384 is enacted
4 into law before the effective date of this subsection.

5 **SECTION 7. Appropriation changes.**

6 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
7 to the department of commerce under section 20.143 (1) (c) of the statutes, as affected
8 by the acts of 2003, the dollar amount is decreased by \$500,000 for fiscal year
9 2003-04 to decrease funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
