Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Counties already incur costs involved in the prosecution, including deferred prosecution, of worthless checks. It is not clear if these costs will change and, if so, in what direction the change would be, were this bill to be enacted. The county costs are exclusive of the fees charged for the class or counseling that would be provided to the person charged with passing the worthless check. The cost analysis would be affected by the previous existence or not of a deferred prosecution program for passing worthless checks. If a new program were established where none existed before then there would be an increase in costs.
