Senator Brown:

This version of the bill incorporates the changes requested at the February 17, 2004, meeting with your staff and others. In reviewing the bill, please note the following:

- 1. See my language in s. 430.408 (4). Because the adoption, amendment, and repeal of rules occurs through the rule promulgation process under ch. 227, I continued to authorize the administrator to promulgate rules for the administration of ch. 430, rather than to adopt, amend, or repeal rules. Rule promulgation authority is the authority to adopt, amend, and repeal rules through that process.
- 2. See my language in s. 430.801 (12). Is the way in which I rewrote that subsection consistent with your intent? I could not tell if it was the specific conduct that was restrained or enjoined or similar conduct of another rental-purchase company in the past that was restrained or enjoined.
- 3. In s. 430.901 (3), in light of s. 430.901 (1) and (2), I continued to apply this provision to violations of s. 430.408 (2) or any provision of ss. 430.401 to 430.407, other than those provisions described in s. 430.901 (1) and (2), and not to the entire chapter. Is this your intent?
