Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

In the past five years the department has received two complaints involving commercial businesses who employed persons performing companionship services and who allegedly were not paid overtime premium pay. In the future with passage of this bill the department will continue to receive these type of complaints and will have to investigate the complaints to determine if the affected employees qualify for the exemptions created in this bill. The department anticipates the exemption determination investigation will probably take as long to complete as the prior investigations. Because of this fact and the low number of cases involved there should be no measurable impact upon the department's workload.

If this bill passes the department will need to update its administrative regulations to reflect the new exemptions. The department believes the updating work will not involve much time or effort and can be absorbed by the department's current staff.

The department anticipates it will update its minimum wage and overtime brochures when it normally reprints these documents which will eliminate any additional printing costs.
