Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates an incentive program for air carrier companies that operate a hub within Wisconsin. The bill requires the Department to make payments to air carriers based on their operations, and the number of passengers boarded at each hub facility. These payments are subject to the current language that define hub facilities, and are subject to increase as defined by the bill. The bill creates a new appropriation within the Department for the purpose of making payments to qualifying air carriers, and requires a sum sufficient transfer from the Transportation Fund to the General Fund to fund the payments.

The Department estimates that any increase in workload or costs associated with the requirements of this bill may be absorbed within existing budgets. The Department does not anticipate requesting additional funds to perform the requirements of this bill.
