Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

- 1. Transfer of \$8,325,000 from the Transportation Fund to the General Fund will occur in Fiscal Year 2006 (based on the Effective Date) and will be a one time transfer.
- 2. Funding for aeronautical activities incentive payments above the amount of the Transportation Fund transfer will be funded from the General Fund and the amount will be sum sufficient.
- 3. Aeronautical activities incentive payments based on revenue passenger enplanements for 2003 as reported by the managers of Wisconsin's eight commercial service air carrier airports.
- 4. As currently defined, three airlines would qualify as hub airlines or subsidiaries and qualify for the aeronautical activities incentive payments Midwest, Skyways Midwest Connect, and Air Wisconsin United Express.
- 5. Annualized cost based on 10-year average of estimated aeronautical activities incentive payments calculated on reported 2003 enplanements and the per passenger subsidies outlined in the bill. (See attachment).
