Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

X This bill authorizes the state superintendent of public instruction to award grants to school districts in the ~~2000-01~~ school year for after-school care programs. To be eligible to receive a grant, a school district must enroll pupils who are eligible to receive money under the federal temporary assistance to needy families (TANF) program and who would otherwise be unsupervised by an adult in the afternoon after school. The state superintendent must evenly distribute the grants among rural, suburban, and urban school districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 4. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) AFTER-SCHOOL CARE GRANTS PROGRAM.

(a) A school board may apply to the state superintendent of public instruction
for a grant to fund an after-school care program for pupils who are eligible to receive
temporary assistance for needy families under 42 USC 601 to 619 and who would
otherwise be unsupervised by an adult in the afternoon after school.

(b) The state superintendent of public instruction shall award grants from the
appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (kn) of the statutes, as created by this act, and shall

1 ensure, to the extent feasible, that the grants are evenly distributed among rural,
2 suburban and urban school districts.

3 (2) TRANSFER OF FUNDS. On July 1, 200⁴, there is transferred \$150,000 from the
