### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This substitute amendment adopts, for state income and franchise tax purposes, section 1201 of Public Law 108–173 as it relates to claiming a deduction for an amount that a person pays into a health savings account. The substitute amendment first applies to taxable years beginning after December 31, 2004.
