

## 2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 3

1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of Carl W. Thompson.

2             Whereas, Carl W. Thompson was born on March 15, 1914, in Washington, D.C.,  
3 and died on September 19, 2002, in Stoughton, Wisconsin; and

4             Whereas, he graduated from Stoughton High School in 1932; and

5             Whereas, he earned a B.S. degree in economics from the University of  
6 Wisconsin–Madison in 1936, an LL.B degree in 1939, and a J.D. degree in 1966; and

7             Whereas, Mr. Thompson married Marian L. Foster on October 3, 1942; and

8             Whereas, he served his country with the U.S. Army during World War II in  
9 military intelligence from 1942 to 1946; and

10            Whereas, following his discharge from the U.S. Army, Mr. Thompson  
11 established a law practice in Stoughton; and

12            Whereas, he began his government career as an alderman on the Stoughton  
13 City Council; and

14            Whereas, Mr. Thompson ran as a Democratic candidate for governor in 1948
