2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Carl W. Thompson.

2 Whereas, Carl W. Thompson was born on March 15, 1914, in Washington, DC,
3 and died on September 19, 2002, in Stoughton, Wisconsin; and

4 Whereas, he graduated from Stoughton High School in 1932; and

5 Whereas, he earned a B.S. degree in economics from the University of
6 Wisconsin ^{Fix; hyphen} Madison in 1936, an LL.B degree in 1939, and a J.D. degree in 1966; and

7 Whereas, Mr. Thompson married Marian L. Foster on October 3, 1942; and

8 Whereas, he served his country with the U.S. Army during World War II in
9 military intelligence from 1942 to 1946; and

10 Whereas, following his discharge from the ^{U.S.} Army, Mr. Thompson established a
11 law practice in Stoughton; and

12 Whereas, he began his government career as an alderman on the Stoughton city
13 council; and

14 Whereas, Mr. Thompson ran as a Democratic candidate for Governor in 1948
15 and 1950; and

1 Whereas, he was a Presidential elector in 1948 and served as Democratic
2 national committeeman from 1949 to 1956; and

3 Whereas, Mr. Thompson was first elected to the Wisconsin Assembly in 1952, *and*
4 serving in the 1953 ~~1953~~ *to* 1957 sessions; and

5 Whereas, he was subsequently elected to the Wisconsin Senate in 1959 to fill
6 the unexpired term of Gaylord Nelson, and served until 1984; and

7 Whereas, during his tenure in the Legislature, Mr. Thompson was known for
8 his dedication to human rights and civil liberties; and

9 *after* 10 Whereas, ~~upon~~ *having* Mr. Thompson's retirement from the Wisconsin Legislature in
11 1984, *he* had served 32 years in the Legislature; and

12 Whereas, after his retirement, Mr. Thompson served as a commissioner on the
13 Labor and Industry Review Commission for ~~six~~ *five* years; now, therefore, be it

14 **Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That** the members of the
15 Wisconsin legislature commend the devoted public service that Carl W. Thompson
16 contributed to this state and his community, express their sorrow at his death, and
17 extend their condolences to his family and friends; and be it further

18 **Resolved, That** the senate chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
19 resolution to Mr. Thompson's wife, Marian, his daughters, Jane Thompson Melby
20 of Champaign, Illinois, Anne Thompson of Pardeeville, Margaret Thompson of
21 Denver, Colorado, and Costa Rica, and Lisa Thompson Eagan of Stoughton; and his
22 sisters, Ruth Curtiss of Darlington and Helen Ratchford of Corvallis, Oregon.
