2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** recognizing February 6 as Ronald Reagan Day in the State of  
2 Wisconsin.

3 Whereas, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background,  
4 worked throughout his life serving freedom and advancing the public good, having  
5 been employed as an entertainer, Union leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of  
6 California, and President of the United States; and

7 Whereas, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for <sup>2</sup>two terms as the  
8 40th President of the United States of America; the <sup>2nd</sup>second of which he earned the  
9 confidence of <sup>three-fifths</sup>3/5 of the electorate and was victorious in 49 of the 50 states in the  
10 general election <sup>em</sup>—a record unsurpassed in the history of American presidential  
11 elections; and

12 Whereas, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President, he  
13 inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation and high  
14 unemployment; and

1) Whereas, during Mr. Reagan's presidency, he worked in a bipartisan manner to  
2) enact his bold agenda of restoring accountability and common sense to Government,  
3) which led to an unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of  
4) Americans; and

5) Whereas, Mr. Reagan's commitment to an active social policy agenda for the  
6) nation's children helped lower crime and drug use in ~~our~~ <sup>of</sup> ~~neighborhoods~~ <sup>America's</sup>; and

7) Whereas, President Reagan's commitment to ~~our~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~armed forces~~ <sup>the</sup> contributed to  
8) the restoration of pride in America, her values, and those cherished by the free world,  
9) and prepared America's ~~Armed~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~Forces~~ to win the Gulf War; and

10) Whereas, President Reagan's vision of "peace through strength" led to the end  
11) of the Cold War and the ultimate demise of the Soviet Union, guaranteeing basic  
12) human rights for millions of people; and

13) Whereas, on February 6, 2003, Ronald Reagan will reach the age of 92 years;  
14) now, therefore, be it

15) *Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That* the Legislature of  
16) the State of Wisconsin hereby recognizes February 6, 2003, and subsequent yearly  
17) anniversaries thereafter as "Ronald Reagan Day."
