(1)	Relating to: recognizing February 6 as Ronald Reagan Day in the State of
2	Wisconsin.
3	Whereas, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background,
4	worked throughout his life serving freedom and advancing the public good, having
5	been employed as an entertainer, Union leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of
6	California, and President of the United States; and
(7)	Whereas, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for two terms as the
(8)	40th President of the United States of America; the second of which he earned the
9	confidence of 3/5 of the electorate and was victorious in 49 of the 50 states in the
	general election a record unsurpassed in the history of American presidential

12	Whereas, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President, he
13	inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation and high
L 4	unemployment; and
