

2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 24

March 13, 2003 – Introduced by Senators WELCH, ZIEN, S. FITZGERALD, DARLING, SCHULTZ, KANAVAS and STEPP, cosponsored by Representatives NASS, KREIBICH, JENSEN, KAUFERT, HUNDERTMARK, GROTHMAN, SUDER, BIES, HINES, HAHN, NISCHKE, PETTIS, JESKEWITZ, KESTELL, KRAWCZYK, LEMAHIEU, VAN ROY, SERATTI and GIELOW. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** commending the families and friends of those soldiers serving on active
2 duty in the Middle East and praying for the prompt and safe return of their
3 loved ones.

4 Whereas, Dictator Saddam Hussein's regime in Iraq continues to pose a
5 significant threat to United States interests; and

6 Whereas, Saddam Hussein, on multiple occasions, has demonstrated a
7 willingness to use weapons of mass destruction, including conventional, chemical,
8 nuclear, and ballistic missile programs against neighboring nations, the citizens of
9 Iraq, and innocent civilians throughout the world; and

10 Whereas, Saddam Hussein's clandestine weapons programs threaten global
11 peace, the United States interests in the Persian Gulf, and the continued stability
12 of roughly 55% of the world's oil reserves; and

13 Whereas, the elimination of the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction,
14 particularly among states that sponsor terrorism, has been the principal goal of the
15 United Nations Security Council; and
