2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of William R. Moser.

2 Whereas, William R. Moser was born on October 14, 1927, in Chicago and died
3 on April 11, 2003, in Milwaukee; and

4 Whereas, he graduated from St. John Cathedral High School, St. Norbert
5 College, and Marquette Law School; and

6 Whereas, after establishing himself in private practice as an attorney, he
7 married Mary Bernadette Reding; and

8 Whereas, he began a long career of public service by joining the U.S. Army in
9 1945, serving ~~two~~² years as a paratrooper and a criminal investigator; and

10 Whereas, William R. Moser was elected to the Wisconsin Senate in 1956,
11 quickly earning a reputation as a passionate statesman and an enemy of posturing
12 and hypocrisy; and

13 Whereas, he became one of the youngest floor leaders in the history of the
14 Wisconsin legislature when in 1961³ at the age of 33[✓], he was elected senate minority
15 leader; and

1 Whereas, in that role he led the fight against the adoption of the sales tax in
2 Wisconsin; and

3 Whereas, after leaving the senate in 1962, William Moser went on to a long
4 career of further service to the people of Milwaukee County[✓] as a county court judge,
5 a^{as} circuit court judge, and finally[✓] as a judge of the District I Court of Appeals; now⁽¹⁾
6 therefore, be it

7 ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That*** the members of the
8 Wisconsin legislature salute the life and public service of William R. Moser and
9 mourn the passing of this distinguished former colleague; and, be it further

10 ***Resolved, That*** the senate chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
11 resolution to William R. Moser's wife[✓], Mary Bernadette[✓], his son⁽¹⁾, William, and his
12 daughter⁽¹⁾ Mary Magdalene Carlson.
