Wisconsin soldier killed in Iraq

RICE LAKE — An Army soldier from Wisconsin killed in Iraq hoped to return home, go to college and eventually become a history teacher, his family said Tuesday.

~~Spc. Paul J. Sturino, 21, of Rice Lake~~, died Monday from a non-hostile gunshot wound, the Army said. He was assigned to the 101st Airborne Division and was in an area south of Mosul in northern Iraq, where the death remains under investigation.

Sturino's grandmother, Marilyn Peer, said the family was awaiting details of what happened.

"We don't know anything," she said. "This is a shock."

Peer took calls at the home of her daughter, Chris Wetzel, who is Sturino's mother.

Sturino is the fourth Wisconsinite killed during military operations in Iraq.

"He was a wonderful kid. He was terrific," the grandmother said. "He loved to fish and hunt. He was always happy. He had the cutest smile."

Sturino joined the Army in July 2001 after graduating from Rice Lake High School, Peer said. "I think he signed up because his older brother was in it."

Sturino, who was single, was assigned to B Battery, 2nd Battalion, 320th Field Artillery Regiment, said John Minton, a spokesman with the Fort Campbell-based division.
