Relating to: commending Donald J. Schneider for his many years of service to the 2 Wisconsin senate and the people of Wisconsin. Whereas, Donald J. Schneider retired as senate chief clerk on July 4, 2003; and 3 Whereas, Donald J. Schneider was born in Sheboygan on May 29, 1947; and 4 Whereas, he served in the United States Air Force from 1966 to 1970; and 5 Whereas, he began his long career of service to the Wisconsin legislature by 6 serving as assistant assembly sergeant at arms during the 1973 and 1975 sessions; 7 8 and Whereas, he was elected senate chief clerk in 1977, beginning an 9 unprecedented tenure of twenty-six and years in that office; and 10 Whereas, he was active throughout his career in the American Society of 11 Legislative Clerks and Secretaries, serving as president in 1983-84, as a member of 12 the Mason's Manual Commission, and as Chair and Nice Chair of numerous 13 committees of the Society; and

17	majorities with aplomb during his long tenure; and
