

1 **Relating to:** honoring Congressman Jerry Kleczka for tireless service to
2 Milwaukee.

3 Whereas, Congressman Jerry Kleczka represents Wisconsin's 4th
4 Congressional District, consisting of the City of Milwaukee and the suburbs of West
5 Milwaukee, St. Francis, Cudahy, South Milwaukee, and part of West Allis; and

6 Whereas, he was first elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly at age 24, and
7 in 1974 he won a seat in the State Senate. He soon assumed leadership posts as
8 Assistant Majority Leader and co-chair of the Legislature's powerful Joint Finance
9 Committee, and *on Finance*

10 Whereas, in 1984, *Jerry* Kleczka was elected to Congress in a special election following
11 the death of *Rep.* Clement Zablocki, *Representative* Kleczka has won 11 consecutive races and was
12 reelected November 5, 2002, with 87% *Mr.* of the vote; and *percent*

13 Whereas, in the *H* House of Representatives, *R* Kleczka serves on the House Ways
14 & Means Committee and its *U.S.* Subcommittees on *Mr.* Health and Oversight. While on that
15 panel, he has worked to push through major health care and spending reforms such

1 as a ban on "drive-through" baby deliveries, and his initiative to limit government
2 disability payments to addicts and alcoholics. Both measures have been made law;
3 and

4 Whereas, ^{Jerry} Kleczka continues to fight for an affordable, meaningful prescription
5 drug Medicare program for all senior citizens and reforms to reduce the cost of health
6 care; and

7 Whereas, ^{Mr.} Kleczka has also developed legislation to protect elderly residents of
8 high-rise public housing from physical harm. His legislation brought widespread
9 praise and resulted in Milwaukee becoming the first city in the nation to provide
10 "elderly only" public housing; and

11 Whereas, a leading advocate of personal privacy issues in Congress, ^{Mr.} Kleczka
12 co-sponsored legislation signed into law that makes identity theft a crime. This year,
13 he has reintroduced the Personal Information Privacy Act, which would make it
14 illegal for a business to withhold products or services if a consumer refused to furnish
15 a Social Security number for identification purposes; and

16 Whereas, an active voice in the community, ^{Jerry} Kleczka is a member of the Hispanic
17 Chamber of Commerce, the Brady Street Area Association, and America's Black
18 Holocaust Museum; and

19 Whereas, the 4th Congressional District is home to several famous business
20 and industries, such as Miller Brewing Company, Harley-Davidson, Briggs &
21 Stratton, and Rockwell Automation/Allen Bradley, designer and manufacturer of
22 industrial automation control products; and

23 Whereas, the ethnic makeup of the district is very diverse, featuring significant
24 German and Polish American populations as well as the largest African American,
25 Hispanic, and Hmong communities in Wisconsin; and


