Whereas, Specialist Hoyer went to Iraq as a Private First Class and was promoted to Specialist during his service; and

Whereas, Specialist Hoyer was a loving and devoted son to Larry and Peggy Hoyer; and

Whereas, Specialist Hoyer earned the Army Service Medal for basic service and AIT training, and the Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal; and

Whereas, Specialist Hoyer lived for a brief time in Ely, Minnesota, before returning to Ellsworth, where he graduated from Ellsworth High School; and

Whereas, Specialist Hoyer will always be remembered for his bravery, courage, and love of family and friends; now, therefore, be it
