

2003 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 73

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Paul Offner.

2 Whereas, Paul Offner was born on August 7, 1942, in Bennington, Vermont,
3 and died on April 20, 2004, in Washington, D.C.; and

4 Whereas, he earned a BA degree from Amherst College in 1964, a master's
5 degree from Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and
6 International Affairs, and a Ph.D. degree in economics from Princeton University in
7 1970; and

8 Whereas, Dr. Offner was first elected to the Wisconsin assembly in 1974,
9 serving in the 1975 session; and

10 Whereas, he was subsequently elected to the Wisconsin senate in 1976, serving
11 in the 1977 through 1983 sessions; and

12 Whereas, during the 1983 session, Dr. Offner served as assistant senate
13 majority leader; and
