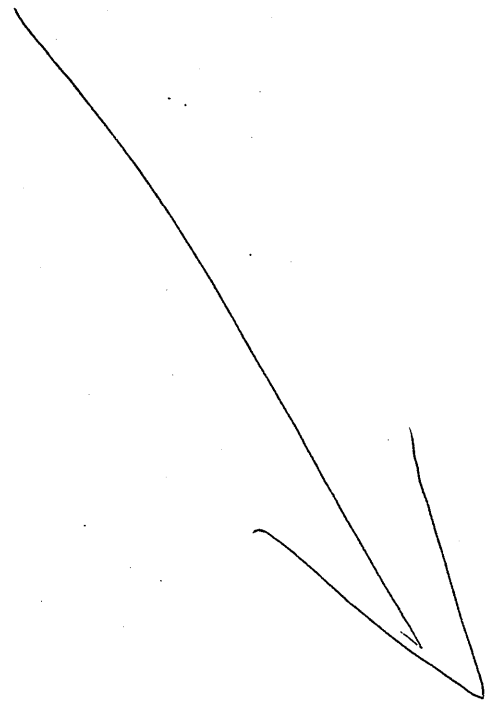

SENATE RULE 95M. Campaign contributions. (1) In this rule:

(a) "Contribution," "legislative campaign committee," and "personal campaign committee" have the meanings given for the terms in section 11.01 of the statutes.

(b) "legislative leader" means the Majority Leader, Minority Leader or a senate member of the joint committee on finance.

(2) A legislative leader may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize a legislative campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; and a legislative leader ma not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make or receive a contribution for or at; or

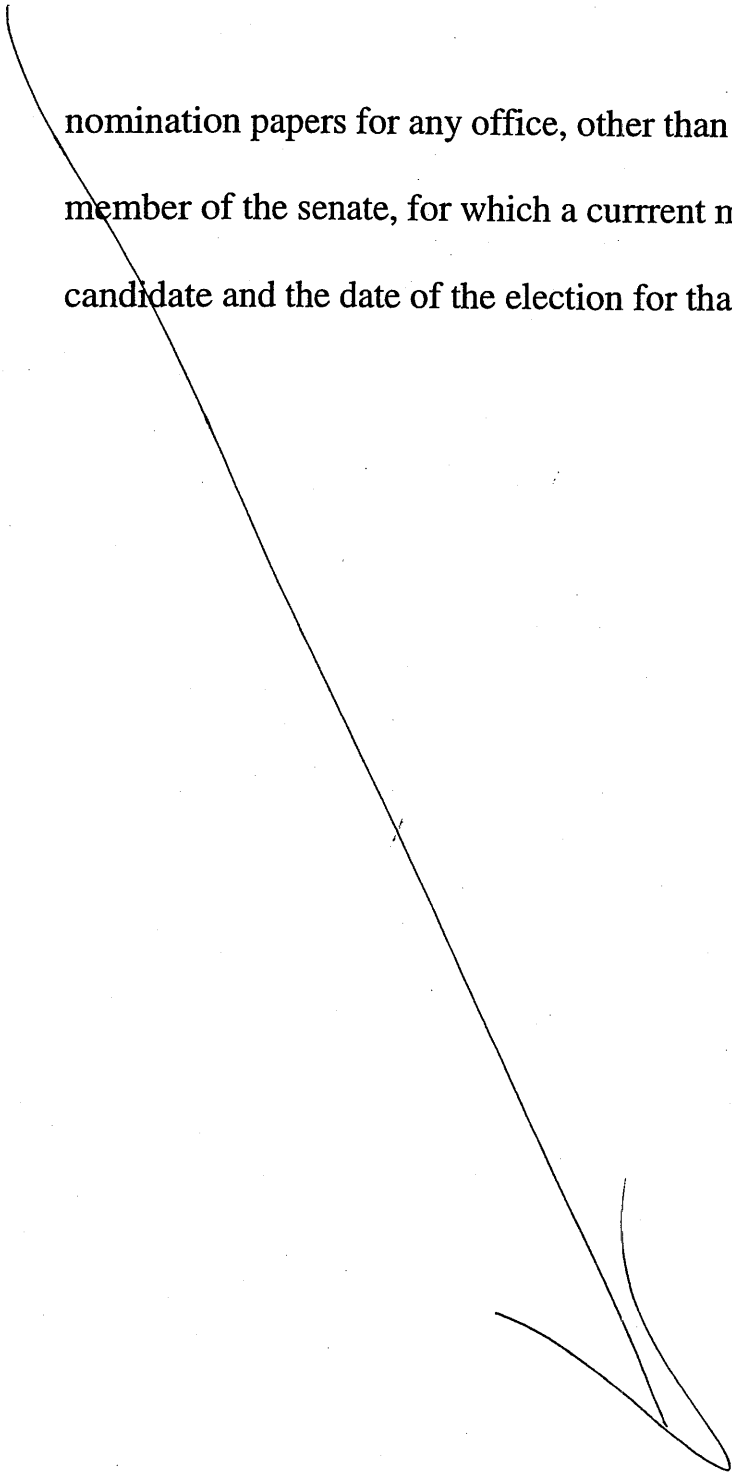
authorize his or her personal campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; a fund-raising social event or otherwise after January 1 of the odd-numbered year and before the date of enactment, as defined in section 35.095(1)(a) of the statutes, of the executive budget bill introduced under section 16.47(1) of the statutes.

(3) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a legislative campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nominations papers for any special election to the senate and the date of special election.

(4) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fundraising social event of a current member of the senate or his or her personal campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office for which a current member of the senate is a candidate and the date of the election for that office, if the event is held within the boundaries of the jurisdiction or district served by the office for which the current member of the senate is a candidate.

(5) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current member of the senate or his or her personal campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing

nomination papers for any office, other than senator, in the case of a member of the senate, for which a current member of the senate is a candidate and the date of the election for that other office.”

16 member of the senate or his or her personal campaign committee held during the
17 period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office,
18 other than senator, in the case of a member of the senate, for which a current member
19 of the senate is a candidate and the date of the election for that other office.”.
