authorize his or her pesonal campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; a fund-raising social event or otherwise after January 1 of the odd-numbered year and before the date of enactment, as defined in section 35.095(1)(a) of the statutes, of the executive budget bill introduced under section 16.47(1) of the statutes.

- (3) Subsection (2) does not aply to a fund-raising social event of a legislative campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nominations papers for any special election to the senate and the date of special election.
