



5 servicemen and servicewomen in serving our country ^{STET} by ensuring that the needs of
6 not only the families of those soldiers who give their lives, but also ^{STET} that the needs of
7 the returning soldiers and their families, will be protected in the areas of health care,
8 education, employment, and housing; and, be it further^{STET}.
