

## 2003 SENATE RESOLUTION 11

June 24, 2003 – Introduced by Senator CARPENTER. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **To amend** senate rule 76 (1), senate rule 77 (1) and (3) and senate rule 80; **relating**  
2     **to:** limits on debate.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This resolution changes the senate rules to prohibit cutting off debate unless approved by a vote of two-thirds of the members present.

### ***Resolved by the senate, That:***

3     **SECTION 1.** Senate rule 76 (1) is amended to read:

4     SENATE RULE 76 (1) Time limits and schedules for debate may be designated in  
5     the manner described in sub. (2). The time limits may be rejected or modified by  
6     majority vote of the senate a vote of two-thirds of the members present, but this  
7     question is not debatable. The schedules and time limits shall be announced by the  
8     presiding officer immediately upon being presented. Promptly at the expiration of  
9     the time allotted, the presiding officer shall put the question.
