SENATE AMENDMENT,  
TO 2003 SENATE RESOLUTION 21

1 At the locations indicated, amend the resolution as follows:

2 ✓ 1. Page 2, line 2: after “day.” insert “If the presiding officer orders a member  
3 escorted out of the senate chamber, the presiding officer shall immediately put the  
4 question “Shall the decision of the presiding officer stand as the judgment of the  
5 senate?”.”<sup>✓</sup> Notwithstanding rules 68,<sup>✓</sup> 76,<sup>✓</sup> 77,<sup>✓</sup> and 78,<sup>✓</sup> debate on the question may not  
6 be limited. The member may not be escorted out of the chamber unless the senate  
7 affirms the decision of the presiding officer.”.
