Cemetery, Funeral and Burial Expenses for Public Assistance Clients

Current Language

S.20.435(4)(bn), the DHFS Income Maintenance budget appropriation, provides that funding in the appropriation be used for the administration of medical assistance, BadgerCare, and the food stamps program.

S.49.33 defines Income Maintenance administration.

Proposed Change

Revise s.20.435(4)(bn) to specify that funding in the appropriation can be used for the administration of other Income Maintenance programs, as well as MA, BadgerCare, and food stamps.

Replace the term "Income Maintenance" with "Eligibility Management" in s.20.435(4)(bn), s.49.33, and elsewhere.

Effect of Change

The first proposed change will clarify that funding for Income Maintenance programs other than MA, BadgerCare, and Food Stamps, such as the cemetery, funeral and burial program for public assistance clients, will be budgeted in the DHFS Income Maintenance budget appropriation. The second proposed change will eliminate the term "Income Maintenance", which is obsolete and inaccurate, and replace it with the clearer and more accurate term "Eligibility Management".

Rationale for the Change

Cemetery, funeral and burial expenses are administered as part of the state's Income Maintenance (IM) activities. Responsibility for IM functions transferred from the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) to DHFS on July 1, 2002. In its 03-05 biennial budget request, DHFS is requesting that the funding for cemetery, funeral and burial expenses transfer from DWD to DHFS. The proposed change will clarify that the DHFS Income Maintenance appropriation, s.20.435(4)(bn) is the appropriate budget appropriation for the cemetery, funeral and burial funding. "Income Maintenance" is an obsolete, inaccurate, and misleading description

PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

Under current law, DHFS contracts with county departments of social services or human services (county departments) to administer "income maintenance" programs and reimburses the county departments for their costs of administering those programs. An "income maintenance" program is defined as Medical Assistance, Badger Care, or the food stamp program.

This bill makes a number of changes related to "income maintenance" programs. Because the term "income maintenance" does not accurately describe what the specified programs are intended to accomplish, the bill redefines Medical Assistance, Badger Care, and the food stamp program as "family support" programs. Because county departments are responsible for determining eligibility for benefits under the specified programs, the bill substitutes the term "eligibility management" for "income maintenance" where appropriate. In addition, the bill categorizes as a "family support" program a program under current law under which county departments pay cemetery, funeral, and burial expenses for decedents who, during life, received certain public assistance benefits, including Wisconsin Works benefits and Medical Assistance benefits. 

- 2. The term "income maintenance" under current law is used to describe the programs that are included in s. 49.33 (1) (b). It does not seem to me that those programs could be described as "eligibility management" programs. It seems to me that "eligibility management" is, instead, what the county departments do with respect to those programs. For that reason, I called the programs "family support" programs, as you suggested, and used "eligibility management" to describe what the county departments do instead of administering the programs. If this is not acceptable and what the county departments do should still be called "administration," modifications to this draft may be needed.
- 3. In ss. 20.435 (4) (bn) and 49.33 (2) and (8) (a), I used the phrase "eligibility management under" the family support programs, because of the comparison that you made in our telephone conversation to case management. In other words, cases and eligibility under the programs are managed, not the programs themselves. Let me know, however, if you would prefer "eligibility management of" the family support programs.
- 4. It is unclear from current law that DHFS has anything to do with the program under s. 49:30. The only agency explicitly associated with the program is DWD, which must reimburse county departments under s. 49.30 (2) for the payments they make for cemetery, funeral, and burial expenses. For that reason, the analysis, in explaining the legal change, may not reflect actual practice.



Under current law, DHFS contracts with county departments of social services or human services (county departments) to administer "income maintenance" programs and reimburses the county departments for their costs of administering those programs. An "income maintenance" program is defined as Medical Assistance, Badger Care, or the food stamp program.

This bill categorizes as an "income maintenance" program a program under current law under which county departments pay cemetery, funeral, and burial expenses for decedents who, during life, received certain public assistance benefits, such as Wisconsin Works benefits or Medical Assistance benefits. The county departments are reimbursed for those payments by DWD. The effect of the new categorization is that DHFS will reimburse county departments, from a DHFS general purpose revenue appropriation, for expenses incurred in determining eligibility for that program.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
