## Mental Health/AODA Redesign: Phase II

### Current Language

S. 20.435 (6)(jm) states that all money received from fees paid by certain DHFS regulated providers for the cost of inspecting, licensing and approving facilities, issuing permits and providing technical assistance shall be accredited to this appropriation account. Among the fees deposited in (6)(jm) are certification fees paid by outpatient mental health and alcohol and other drug abuse (AODA) providers.

### Proposed Change

Create session law:

Notwithstanding s. 20.435 (6)(jm) and 51.04, the Department shall allocate for the appropriation under s. 20.435 (6)(jm) \$418,400 in FY 04 and \$280,900 in FY 05 in revenues from certification fees assessed under s. 51.04 for the purpose of funding mental health and alcohol and other drug abuse demonstration projects.

### Effect of the Change

The session law would allow the Department to use a one time surplus of (\$587,700 PRO in mental health and substance abuse provider certification fees) to fund Phase I of the mental health/AODA Redesign demonstration projects in 6 counties (Dane, Milwaukee, Kenosha, Forest, Vilas, and Oneida). In addition, the Department will implement a \$60 increase in the annual certification fee to fund mental health consumer outcome surveys as part of the Redesign effort and the Department's ongoing quality assurance process for certified providers. The increase will generate \$56,300 PRO per year.

### Rationale for the Change

Since January 2001, the Department has piloted Mental Health/AODA Redesign projects in four Wisconsin counties. The goal of the pilots is to provide comprehensive consumer based mental health and substance abuse services in a managed care system. In Phase I of the project, which concluded in June 2002, the pilots began initial development of consumer outcomes and data sets and building capacity for consumer directed services.

To continue work on Mental Health/AODA Redesign, it would be necessary to proceed with Phase II of Wisconsin's Mental Health/AODA Redesign. Phase II will put in place the building blocks to move towards a managed system of care. In addition, Phase II will work on ways to improve access to mental health services, as well as continue to support a consumer-based model of recovery with flexible community services, an improved consumer-defined outcomes monitoring process, performance based contracting, and aggressive coordination of health related services. Efforts of Phase II will focus on four major areas:

- Explorations of appropriate federal waivers, analysis of state plan services and consequent data efforts to promote a flexible array of services.
- Design and implementation of a functional eligibility screen in the demonstration sites.
- Design and implementation of a consumer-focused, outcome based quality assurance/improvement system and performance-based contracting.
- Improved case management and primary health treatment of people with mental illness, substance abuse and other chronic conditions.

In the 2003-2005 biennium the Department is requesting funding to conduct functional screens, construction of an automated, web based functional screen and ongoing costs for the system, fund consumer outcome surveys, and fund data analysis for Phase II of the Mental Health/AODA Redesign.
