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

CIP 1A Reduction Rate

Current Language

S.49.45 (6b)(a) (b), (c)

Proposed Change

Amend s.49.45 (6b) (a), (b) and (c) to change the fiscal year and the reduction rate at the Centers for the Developmentally Disabled to a uniform \$325/day in each year of the 2003-05 biennium.

Effect of the Change

The amount of funding reduced at the Centers for the relocation of individuals into the community will increase from the current \$225/day to \$325/day in FY 04 and FY 05.

Rationale for the Change

The Department proposes to increase the daily placement rate for residents relocated from the Centers into the community to \$325/day in each year of the 2003-05 biennium to ensure that the relocation of individuals from the Centers to community placement will continue. The increase will be offset by increasing the reduction rate at the Centers to the same amount in each year. As a result there will be no cost to the Department's Medicaid program.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Currently, under a waiver of federal Medical Assistance ~~Program~~ laws, DHFS relocates Medical Assistance ~~Program~~ recipients who reside in state centers for the developmentally disabled into their communities by providing to them home and community-based services as part of ~~the~~ Medical Assistance ~~Program~~. For each such relocation, program revenue reimbursement for the state centers for the developmentally disabled in which the person formerly resided is reduced by \$225 per day.

This bill increases to \$325 per day, beginning ^{on} July 1, 2004, the reduction of program revenue reimbursement for a state center for the developmentally disabled following the relocation of a state center resident to the community.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 SECTION 1. 49.45 (6b) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 49.45 (6b) CENTERS FOR THE DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED. From the
3 appropriation under s. 20.435 (2) (gk), the department may reimburse the cost of
4 services provided by the centers for the developmentally disabled. Reimbursement
5 to the centers for the developmentally disabled shall be reduced following each
6 placement made under s. 46.275 that involves a relocation from a center for the
7 developmentally disabled, by ~~\$200 per day, beginning in fiscal year 2001-02, and by~~
8 ~~\$225 per day, beginning in fiscal year 2002-03, and by \$325 per day, beginning in~~
9 fiscal year 2004-05.
