Current Language

S.49.45 (6b)(a) (b), (c)

Proposed Change

Amend s.49.45 (6b) (a), (b) and (c) to change the fiscal year and the reduction rate at the Centers for the Developmentally Disabled to a uniform \$325/day in each year of the 2003-05 biennium.

Effect of the Change

The amount of funding reduced at the Centers for the relocation of individuals into the community will increase from the current \$225/day to \$325/day in FY 04 and FY 05.

Rationale for the Change

The Department proposes to increase the daily placement rate for residents relocated from the Centers into the community to \$325/day in each year of the 2003-05 bienniaum to ensure that the relocation of individuals from the Centers to community placement will continue. The increase will be offset by increasing the reduction rate at the Centers to the same amount in each year. As a result there will be no cost to the Department's Medicaid program.
