**Topic:** Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center Funding

**Current Language**

Current language at §46.057(2) specifies that the Department shall transfer specific funding to DHFS for the specific time periods during the biennium to pay for services for juveniles placed at the Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center (MJTC).

**Proposed Change**

Update the language to allow the transfer of funding to DHFS to pay for MJTC.

§46.057(2) From the appropriation accounts under s.20.410(3)(ba) ~~and the department of corrections shall transfer to the appropriation account under s. 20.435(2)(kx) \$1,379,300 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$1,379,300 in fiscal year 2002-03 and, from the appropriation account under s. 20.410(3)(hm), the department of corrections shall transfer to the appropriation account under s. 20.435(2)(kx)~~ an amount not to exceed the actual cost of providing services for juveniles placed at the Mendota juvenile treatment center. \$2,489,300 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$2,489,900 in fiscal year 2002-03 for services for juveniles placed at the Mendota juvenile treatment center. The department of health and family services may charge the department of corrections not more than the actual cost of providing those services.

**Effect of the Change**

This change will update statutes to allow the transfer of funds from DOC to DHFS without date or funding restrictions.

**Rationale for the Change**

This change is necessary in order to pay DHFS for services used at MJTC. The change will also allow the Department flexibility should it need to use more or less than 29 beds at MJTC.

**CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM**  
**JUVENILE CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM**

Under current law, DHFS operates the Mendota Juvenile Treatment Center (center), as a juvenile secured correctional facility, to provide evaluations and treatment for juveniles whose behavior presents a serious problem to themselves or others in other juvenile secured correctional facilities and whose mental health needs can be met at the center. Currently, DOC is required to transfer to DHFS for those services certain amounts of general purpose revenues and program revenues specified in the statutes. This bill eliminates those certain amounts from the statutes and instead requires DOC to transfer to DHFS in each fiscal year an amount not to exceed the actual cost of providing services for juveniles who are placed at the center.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*
