Update the language to allow the transfer of funding to DHFS to pay for MJTC.

§46.057(2) From the appropriation accounts under s.20.410(3)(ba) and the department of corrections shall transfer to the appropriation account under s. 20.435(2)(kx) \$1,379,300 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$1,379,300 in fiscal year 2002-03 and, from the appropriation account under s. 20.410(3)(hm), the department of corrections shall transfer to the appropriation account under s. 20.435(2)(kx) an amount not to exceed the actual cost of providing services for juveniles placed at the Mendota juvenile treatment center. \$2,489,300 in fiscal year 2001-02 and \$2,489,900 in fiscal year 2002-03 for services for juveniles placed at the Mendota juvenile treatment center. The department of health and family services may charge the department of corrections not more than the actual cost of providing those services.

Effect of the Change

This change will update statutes to allow the transfer of funds from DOC to DHFS without date or funding restrictions.

Rationale for the Change

This change is necessary in order to pay DHFS for services used at MJTC. The change will also allow the Department flexibility should it need to use more or less than 29 beds at MJTC.




