PROPOSED CHANGE: (Changes highlighted in italics.)	ss. 285.69 (3) The department may promulgate rules for the payment and collection of fees for notification or re-notification of and inspecting nonresidential asbestos demolition and renovation projects regulated by the department. The fees under this subsection shall not exceed \$450 for an inspection where a combined square and linear footage is less than 5,000. For an inspection where the combined square footage and linear footage is at or greater than 5,000, the fee shall not exceed \$750. Fees for initial re-notification shall not exceed one-half the original notification and inspection fee.
EXPLANATORY NOTE:	Statutory language change is needed to allow for collection of additional Asbestos Program fees. Additional staff and funding are needed to effectively run the federally delegated Asbestos Program. Currently, the Air Program is using staff resources, totaling from two to four extra FTE positions, answering asbestos related complaints. The funding request also includes an automated notification system and funding for County and City Health Departments to conduct inspections for Air Management. The Budget Bill for 1999-2001 authorized a \$10 fee increase rather than the \$100 requested and has provided minimal funding. This fee increase was effective on February 1, 2002.

Carole Scheaffer:

This is the draft relating to increasing asbestos fees. The instructions did not explain how "combined square and linear feet" should be measured or what material was to be measured. I based the language relating to this on DNR's rules (see Wis. Adm. Code NR 410.05).

I do not understand what DNR is getting at in referring to fees for notification and renotification. I do not see any reference to renotification in the asbestos rules. The statutes authorize DNR to collect two fees from persons who want to conduct asbestos demolition and renovation projects a fee for reviewing and acting on a request for an exemption from having to obtain an air emission fee (see s. 285.69 (1) (c)) and the inspection fee. If the idea behind this request is to charge for something other than an inspection or reinspection, perhaps DNR should increase the exemption review fee. At any rate, you may wish to discuss this matter with the DNR contact persons, or let me know and I will contact them.
