





<b>EXPLANATORY NOTE:</b>	Repayments of advances for projects under the traditional priority watershed program have been deposited to program revenue appropriation s. 20.370 (6)(ag) [Appropriation 625] when the projects for which the money was advanced were not implemented. The priority watershed program is administered under the authority listed in s. 281.65, Stats. However, the Legislature has expanded the Department's nonpoint source grant programs to include the urban nonpoint source program under s. 281.66, Stats., and the municipal flood control and riparian restoration program under s. 281.665 Stats. Further, the Department is proposing a nonpoint source performance standards financial assistance program under a newly created s. 281.663, Stats. It is likely that routine department audits of these grant programs may identify repayments owed to the Department as a result of overpayments or accidental double billings. This amendment would allow the Department to recoup those payments and apply them toward the various nonpoint source financial assistance programs, as was originally intended when the money was appropriated.

Please revise this draft so that repayments made under the priority watershed program (281.65) are directed to the bond sinking and redemption fund for payment of debt service on bonds related to the program.

In other words, where the original intent was to direct repayments from additional DNR nonpoint programs toward nonpoint, the new intent is to direct priority watershed repayments toward debt service.
