PROPOSED CHANGE:	<p>Change the SEG appropriation for urban nonpoint source water pollution abatement and municipal flood control programs from annual to continuing.</p> <p>20.370(6)(dq) <i>Environmental Aids;- urban nonpoint source.</i> <u>As a continuing appropriation</u> from the environmental fund, the amounts in the schedule to provide financial assistance for urban nonpoint source water pollution abatement and storm water management under s. 281.66 and for municipal flood control and riparian restoration under s. 281.665.</p>
EXPLANATORY NOTE:	<p>In FY 02, requests for grants from the urban storm water program were \$18.3 million and requests for grants from the municipal flood control program were \$22.7 million. However, only \$4.2 million in bonding was available for the FY 2001-2003 biennium. Requests for funds far exceed available resources. Demand is expected to grow over the years as the non-agricultural performance standards and federal phase 2 storm water regulations place increasing requirements on urban areas to control and manage storm water runoff. This request will allow the Department to manage these limited resources in the most cost-effective fashion, ensuring the maximum water quality and flood control benefits over the greatest number of municipalities.</p>
