Fees for non-voluntary enforcement actions involving technical review of environmental response action documents
Require persons that are subject to enforcement actions under s. 292.11 or 292.31, Stats., to pay the department for the cost of reviewing the response action documents associated with the enforcement action.
Presently, cooperating parties conducting an environmental investigation, cleanup or other related action pay the department for any technical reviews or approvals those persons may request. In contrast, persons subject to an enforcement action or those being compelled to clean up, are not required to reimburse the department for time spent reviewing those documents. This change would require those persons subject to an enforcement document to pay for department review of technical documents, even if they did not request such a review.
