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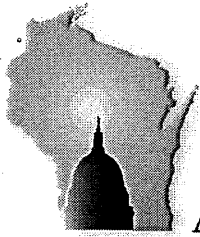

AGRICULTURE

Under current law, DATCP administers the Soil and Water Resource Management Program. The program includes grants for land and water resource management projects and for the construction of animal waste management systems. Current law authorizes the issuance of up to \$13,575,000 in state general obligation bonds for this program. This bill increases the bonding authority by \$17,000,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
