Under current law, there is appropriated to the Technology for Educational Achievement in Wisconsin (TEACH) Board general purpose revenues for distance education and educational technology grants and program revenues for grants to public libraries for the installation of high-speed Internet data lines. The authority to encumber those general purpose revenues expired on June 30, 1998, and the authority to encumber those program revenues expired on June 30, 2002. This bill eliminates those obsolete appropriations.

Under current law, certain program revenues received from a settlement with Ameritech Wisconsin are appropriated to the TEACH Board for educational technology block grants to school districts and certain program revenues received from the Wisconsin Advanced Telecommunications Foundation are appropriated to the TEACH Board for educational technology block grants to school districts, secured correctional facilities, and charter schools. This bill eliminates those appropriations.

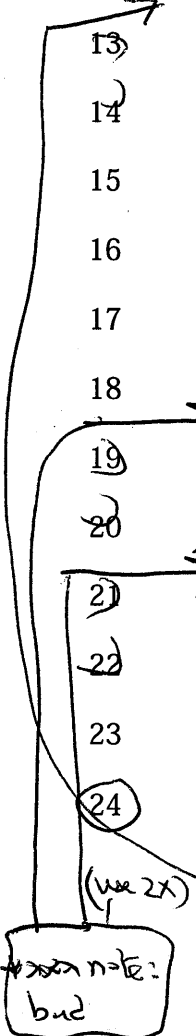

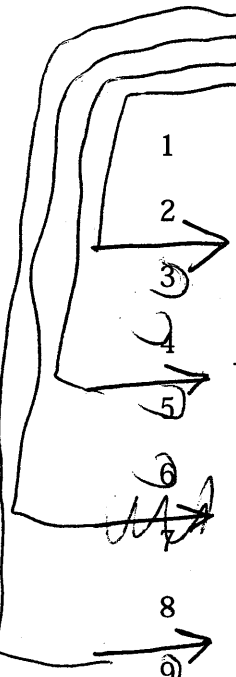

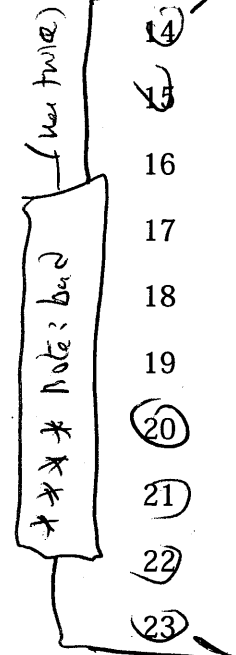

Under current law, the Technology for Educational Achievement in Wisconsin (TEACH) Board, which is attached to DOA for administrative purposes, administers certain educational technology programs, including programs under which the TEACH Board awards educational technology block grants to school districts and juvenile secured correctional facilities; awards educational technology training and technical assistance grants to cooperative educational service agencies (CESAs) and to consortia of school districts, charter school sponsors, juvenile secured correctional facilities, public library boards, and CESAs; provides educational technology infrastructure financial assistance to school districts, charter school sponsors, and public library boards; and provides subsidized telecommunications access to various educational agencies. The TEACH Board is also required to promote the efficient, cost-effective procurement, installation, and maintenance of educational technology by school districts, CESAs, technical college districts, and the University of Wisconsin (UW) System, to enter into cooperative purchasing agreements under which school districts and CESAs may contract for educational technology training for their professional employees, to coordinate the purchasing of educational technology materials, supplies, equipment, and contractual services by DOA for school districts, CESAs, technical college districts, and the UW System, and to purchase educational technology equipment for use by school districts, CESAs, and public educational institutions and to permit those entities to purchase or lease, with an option to purchase, that equipment from the TEACH Board.

This bill eliminates the TEACH Board and the position of executive director of the TEACH Board and transfers to DPI all of the TEACH Board's duties, assets and liabilities, positions and employees, other than the executive director, tangible personal property, contracts, rules and order, and pending matters.

In reviewing this draft, please note all of the following changes made from ~~06b3033/2~~:

1. This draft amends s. 16.71 (4) to authorize DOA to delegate to DPI the authority to enter into educational technology training contracts for school district and CESA employees under s. 44.71 (2) (c). Currently, s. 16.71 (4) only authorizes DOA to delegate the authority to enter into contracts for the purchase of equipment. Also, because s. 16.71 (4) requires DOA to delegate the authority to enter into contracts only upon request, the draft restores a requirement in s. 44.71 (2) (c) that DPI obtain the consent of DOA before entering into a cooperative purchasing agreement for educational technology training.

2. This draft deletes, in s. 20.275 (1) (et), an obsolete reference to educational technology training grants under 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9148 (2g). Similarly, the draft deletes in s. 20.275 (1) (s) an obsolete reference to distance learning grants under 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9148 (4w).

3. This draft repeals s. 20.275 (1) (i), (im), and (jm) as obsolete and eliminates cross-references to those obsolete provisions in ss. 20.275 (1) (f) and 44.72 (2) (b) 2.

4. This draft amends s. 20.275 (1) (s), (t), (tm), and (tu) to cross-reference s. 20.530 (1) (g) in those provisions rather than s. 20.530 (1) (is) and (kL), which were folded into s. 20.530 (1) (g) by the governor's partial veto of 2001 Act 16. *Wisconsin*

5. This draft adds a reference to charter school sponsors in s. 20.866 (2) (zc).

This draft amends s. 16.71 (4) to authorize DOA to delegate to DPI the authority to enter into educational technology training contracts for school district and CESA employees under s. 44.71 (2) (c). Currently, s. 16.71 (4) only authorizes DOA to delegate the authority to enter into contracts for the purchase of equipment. Also, because s. 16.71 (4) requires DOA to delegate the authority to enter into contracts only upon request, the draft restores a requirement in s. 44.71 (2) (c) that DPI obtain the consent of DOA before entering into a cooperative purchasing agreement for educational technology training.
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4. This draft amends s. 20.275 (1) (s), (t), (tm), and (tu) to cross-reference s. 20.530 (1) (g) in those provisions rather than s. 20.530 (1) (is) and (kL), which were folded into s. 20.530 (1) (g) by the governor's partial veto of 2001 Wisconsin Act 16.

Hi Gordon --

I want to forward some revisions of Draft 666 (love the draft number!) to you. We will be deleting the technology block grant program and the training and technical assistance grant program in their entirety and making other changes:

- ✍ Delete 20.255(4)(et) and all related references to the educational technology training and technical assistance grants. This program will no longer exist at all.
- ✍ Delete 20.255(4)(f) and all related references to the educational technology block grants. This program will no longer exist at all.
- ✍ Delete 20.255(4)(g). DPI's appropriation 20.255(1)(jr) will be sufficient for this purpose. (Funding the Governor's Wisconsin Educational Technology Conference, or GWETC.)
- ✍ Delete 20.255(4)(k). DPI's appropriation 20.255(1)(ke) will be sufficient for this purpose (if any.)
- ✍ Delete 20.255(4)(m). DPI's appropriation 20.255(1)(me) will be sufficient for this purpose (if any.)
- ✍ For appropriation 20.255(4)(mp), specify that all federal e-rate funding received will be used to forgive school district and library debt service for their wiring loans. After all school district and library debt service for a given year is paid off, any remaining e-rate funding will be used to pay off the state's debt service for wiring loan. Stipulate that DPI may not make any new wiring loans after the effective date of the bill. 44.72(4)
