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

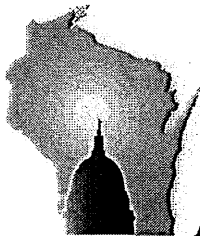

Currently, general purpose revenues are appropriated in DOA[✓] for fiscal year 2001-02 to provide grants to the Wisconsin Patient Safety Institute, Inc. The grant program for the Wisconsin Patient Safety Institute, Inc., was eliminated under 2001 Wisconsin Act 1609. *

This bill eliminates the appropriation of general purpose revenues in DOA for grants to the Wisconsin Patient Safety Institute, Inc.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 20.505 (1) (fe)^X of the statutes is repealed.
