I am forwarding statutory language changes that the State Prosecutors Office included with its budget submission. Most of these requests extend funding and/ or position authority for the 2003-05 biennium, and are similar to language requests drafted for 2001 Act 16.

3. Enact language to specify fiscal years and amounts spent to continue one assistant district attorney (ADA) position to prosecute drug crimes. The position is located in the Dane County DA office, is funded through the multijurisdictional enforcement group and would require \$186,500. Please see the attachment.

Section 9101(2) of 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 (the DOA (OJA) nonstatutory language part of the budget) must continue in the 2003-2005 budget proposal and must specify the fiscal years in which and the amounts of funds that may be spent to continue one assistant district attorney to prosecute drug crimes. This prosecutor is located in the Dane District Attorney's Office and is funded through the Dane County multijurisdictional enforcement group. Specify \$90,600 in FY 04 and \$95,900 in FY 05. The language should be the same as in 2001-2003.
