Language Drafts (Corrected letter)

I am forwarding statutory language changes that the State Prosecutors Office included with its budget submission. Most of these requests extend funding and/ or position authority for the 2003-05 biennium, and are similar to language requests drafted for 2001 Act 16.

4. Enact language to continue funding for three ADA positions for FY03-05, funded through the Federal Byrne program, for Milwaukee County Multijurisdictional enforcement group, Milwaukee DA office, to prosecute chapter 961 drug crime violations. This would require \$581,200. Please see the attachment.

Section 9101(3) of 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 (the DOA (OJA) nonstatutory language part of the budget) must continue in the 2003-2005 budget proposal and must specify the fiscal years in which and the amounts of funds that may be spent to continue three assistant district attorneys to prosecute drug crimes. These prosecutors are located in the Milwaukee District Attorney's Office and are funded through the Milwaukee County multijurisdictional enforcement group.
