#### **DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE:**

The Department requests authority to move the department-wide postage activity into appropriation 467, an existing "service center" appropriation.

Amend s. 20.395(4)(es) Wis. Stats., to include "postage" among the stated purposes of the appropriation and to increase the spending authority by \$4,564,200 SEG-S in FY 04 and \$4,472,400 SEG-S in FY 05 for the department-wide postage activity. The change would be effective July 1, 2003.

#### JUSTIFICATION:

Currently, the Department's postage inventory is acquired and charged to a revenue account within the Division of Motor Vehicle's annual appropriation 563. Placing postage within a department service center in a continuing appropriation will resolve the technical problem of requiring the postage account to net to zero each year because postage inventory cannot be counted as an asset in appropriation 563. Currently, funds must be allocated at the fiscal year-end to cover postage expenditures. The same level of accountability for monitoring postage expenditures and inventory will be maintained. Postage will be charged to the appropriate division as used throughout the year, and unallocated expenditures must be covered by postage inventory. Postage expenditures for the six divisions and executive offices are projected to be \$516,200 in FY 04 and \$523,900 in FY 05
