**Purpose of Draft:** State law under s. 445.125 (1)(a)2. defines irrevocable burial trusts as trusts in amounts up to \$3,300 in value. Such a trust is exempt from consideration as a countable asset for purposes of MA eligibility determination. This draft would reduce this level from \$3,300 to \$1,500 as of July 1, 2004.
