

I would like to make the following addition to draft 1301 (Charging fees for consulting services). In s. 115.28 (30)(b) make the following changes:

1. Reduce the number of agriculture education consultants from two to one.
2. Reduce the number of business education consultants from two to one.
3. Reduce the number of technology education consultants from two to one.
4. Reduce the number of family and consumer sciences education consultants from two to one.
5. Reduce the number of marketing education consultants from two to one.
6. Reduce the health science education consultant from one to .50.

This is a long way of saying we are cutting the number of vocational education consultants in half. Best, Steve
