Request Description:

Repeal the provisions enacted in the 2001-03 biennial budget that established a program to regulate pet breeders, dealers, kennels and shelters except do not repeal any provisions that authorize the department or other state or local government official to respond to specific complaints or information regarding inhumane treatment of animals.

(It seems to me that the only section affected by this drafting request is s. 173.40 and that repealing that section would not affect the authority of humane officers or law enforcement officers from investigating cruelty complaints.)
