Regarding your question on how to draft language making s. 20.370(7)(au) take precedence over s. 20.370(7)(aa) for payment of debt service on bonding used for acquisition or development of state forests......

I spoke with Frank Hoadley, and we would suggest adding a sentence in between the two current sentences stating something along the lines of "The department shall make payments under this paragraph before making payments under par. (aa) for the payment of principal and interest costs incurred in financing s. 20.866(2)(ta) and (tz)."

Another option may be to add a sentence or phrase to s. 20.370(7)(aa) indicating that payments may not be made from s. 20.370(7)(aa) related to principal and interest costs incurred in financing land acquisition and development of state forests under s. 20.866(2)(ta) and (tz) until all available funding under s. 20.370(7)(au) has been expended. Or language similar to that in s. 20.370(7)(ba) ["to the extent that these payments are not made under par. (bq)"].

You may need to do some combination of the second approach and the first. I think that the second approach is more like how things have been drafted in the past, though I have not delved into it very far.
