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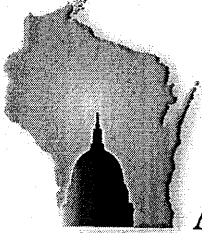

DOA JCF Current law requires the Department of Public Instruction, the Department of Administration and the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to certify to the Joint Committee on Finance by May 15 of each year an estimate of the amount necessary in the equalization aid appropriation which, in combination with the amounts provided in the other state aid and levy credit appropriations, would fund two-thirds of statewide school costs (two-thirds funding).

This bill eliminates two-thirds funding beginning in the 2004-05 school year. For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

Lonnie --

The following drafts will all be IN the budget bill:

1558 -- deleting the primary aid hold harmless

1563 -- deleting the 2/3rds commitment

1599 -- use of transportation \$\$ to provide an increase to general school aids.

Two changes are needed to these drafts, however.

1. #1558 -- Please make the deletion of the primary aid hold harmless effective with FY04 (rather than FY05).
2. #1563 -- Please make the deletion of the 2/3rds commitment and the deletion of the related definition of partial school revenues effective with FY04 (rather than FY05). (This may not require any change, but the intent has changed for the repeal to be effective beginning FY04.)
